General

- Passports
- Cruise Documentation and luggage tags
- Excursion Documents
- Medical Insurance cards
- Medallion if mailed to home, otherwise pick up at port
- Camera, phone, kindle, iPad etc. and accessories
- Chargers for electronics
- Back up charger for long excursion days
- Binoculars (My favorite here)
- Credit cards (multiple in case of loss) I love my Schwab Card because there are NO ATM charges applied ever!
- Cash (I usually bring around \$200 with some small bills for tipping)
- Ear plugs
- Eye Mask
- Refillable Water Bottle
- Batteries if needed
- Wine? Our cruise line allows a wine allotment of one 750 ml per guest

Packing Gear

- Carry-on Suitcase (Yup, that's it!)
- Packing Cubes (email me for suggestions!)
- Waterproof phone/camera holders for excursions
- Personal Item carry on such as a backpack for all your incidentals. This is my NEW FAVORITE! Love it, bought it for my other traveling friend and she loves it too.
- Belt bag that goes everywhere (my current favorite here)
- Small, small purse if you need it (My husband gets to carry my lipstick...

Shipwear

- 1 pair jeans or the like
- Leggings or joggers
- 2 pair nicer pants for shows and dinner
- Dressier outfit for formal?
- 2-3 t-shirts or camis for layering
- 3-4 long sleeved shirts to layer or wear alone
- 2-3 sweaters to layer
- 1 sweatshirt to bum around in the cabin
- 2 workout outfits (if that's your thing, we work out everyday)
- 1 bathing suit (well, maybe 2, lol)
- Cover Up
- Sleepwear
- Underwear (2 bras-one for sport)
- Walking/hiking shoes if needed
- Workout shoes
- Flip Flops
- Shoes for going out that work with all your outfits

- 2 workout socks
- 2 hiking socks
- Belt
